



We wanted to let you know what you might need to pack and what you'll already have available.

The upstairs bedrooms are equipped with one double-sized bed in each of three of the bedrooms and two single-sized beds in the front bedroom. The master bedroom on the first floor has a double-sized bed. The beds all have mattress pads, pillows, a blanket, and a comforter bedspread. All the pillows have decorative pillow shams that should be replaced with your pillow cases. **You should bring sheets and pillowcases for each of them.**

The bathrooms have the toilet paper supplied, so **all you need is your bar soap, shampoo, towels, and washcloths.**

The kitchen is fully equipped with pots, pans, and utensils. There are two drip coffee makers and a coffee grinder. We supply the coffee filters. We also supply paper towels, and napkins in the kitchen, along with dish detergent and dishwasher detergent. We supply dishtowels and dish cloths. There is also a supply of plastic wrap, plastic bags, and aluminum foil. We have flour, sugar, salt and pepper, and some other spices. **You should bring any special spices and bring extra sugar if you plan on using large quantities.**

We supply clear garbage bags for the waste basket and recyclables container in the kitchen. There are 3 large garbage cans in the basement along with 3 containers for sorting the recyclables. The town recycles all newspapers, glass containers, metal containers, and plastic containers with a 1 or 2 recycle code. You can't put them in the regular garbage, and they need to be rinsed out so there's no food in them. We've supplied some used cardboard milk containers to hold any bacon grease since you can't put it in recyclable containers. You are responsible for taking your garbage and recyclables to the Town Dump on Limekiln Road. It is open from 9 – 6 every day except Tuesday (every day during the summer). We have directions above the garbage cans in the basement.

You can leave your soda deposit containers at the dump. They use the proceeds to help fund the local library. If you want to redeem them yourselves, you'll need to return them to the store where you bought them.

The laundry has Tide detergent and dryer sheets.

There is a propane gas grill, so you won't need any charcoal. We also have firewood for the fireplaces and for the fire pit by the shore.

There are lawn chairs at the beach and a bench by the shore at the beach around the point.

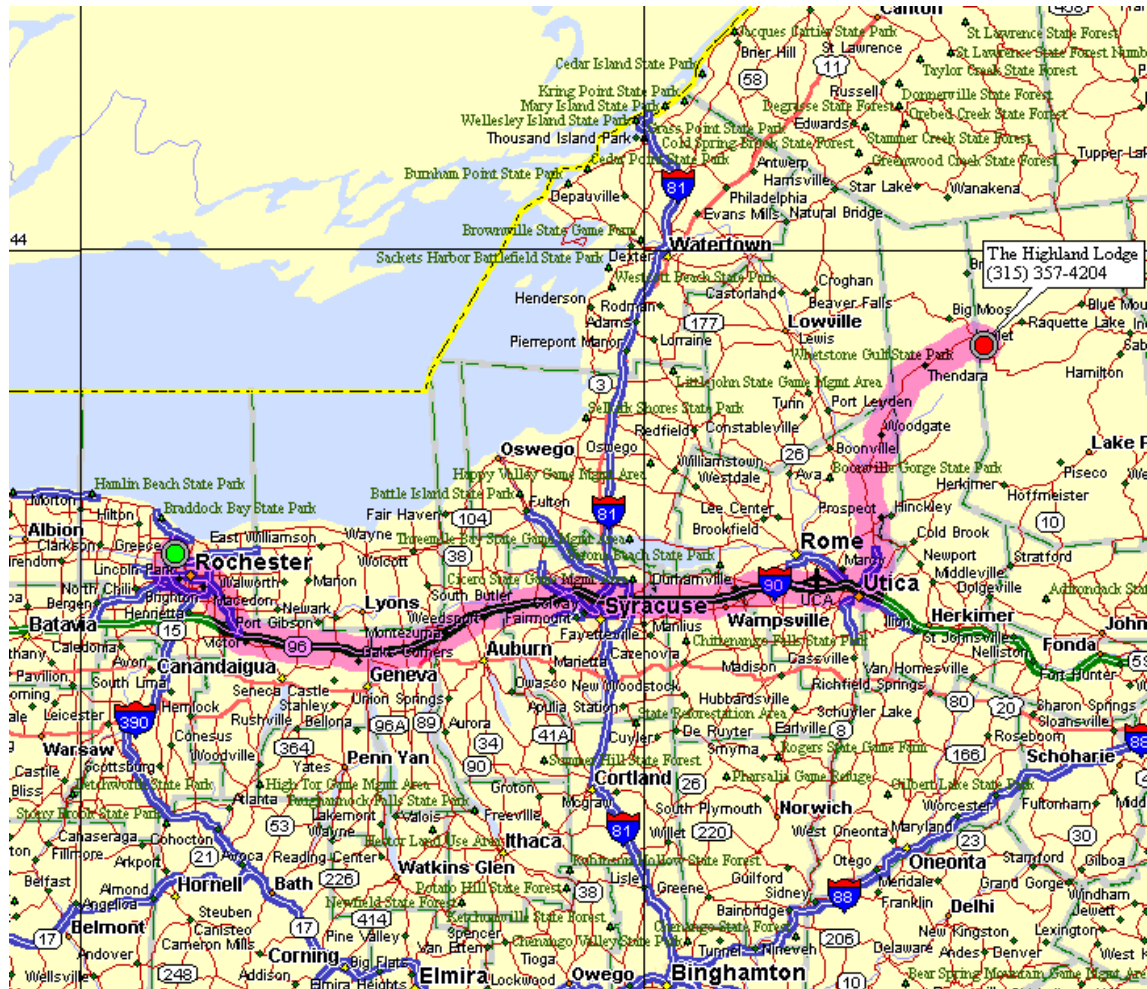
Directions to the Highland Lodge:

Coming from Utica: Take Route 12 to Route 28 East. Follow Route 28 through Old Forge and Eagle Bay to **Inlet, NY**. As you go past *Nelson's Cottages*, look for an Adopt-A-Highway sign at the State Boat Launch. The driveway is immediately on the right after that sign. The Highland Lodge is the third and last one on that driveway.

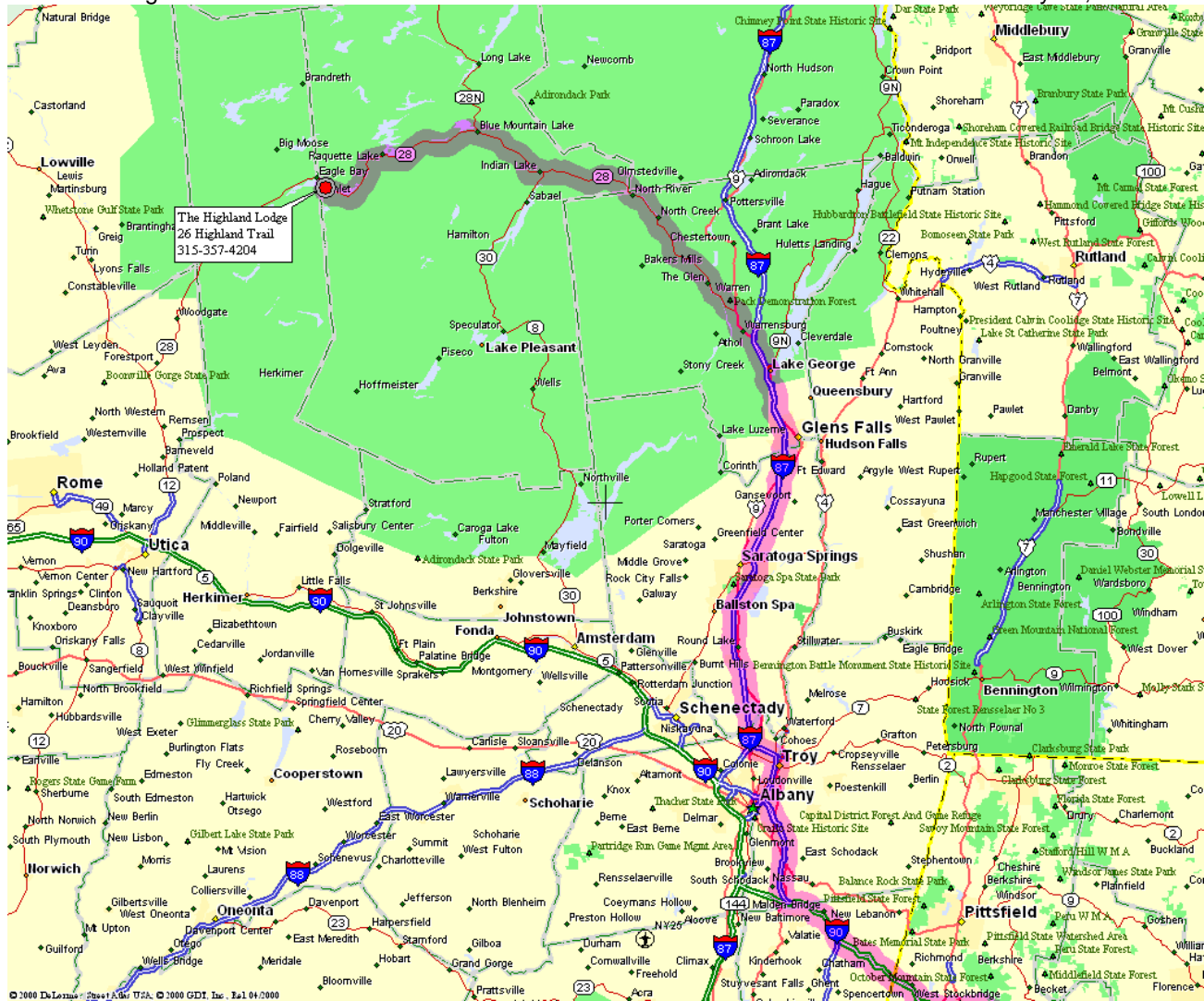
Coming from Albany: Follow I-87 (Northway) north from Albany about 58 miles to exit 23 at Warrensburg. Go through Warrensburg on Route 9 for about 4 miles to the beginning of Route 28. Follow Route 28 for about 68 miles through the mountains to **Inlet, NY**, being careful to turn left at Blue Mountain Lake when Route 28 has a "T" intersection with the beginning of Route 28N and 30. After you go through Inlet and proceed up the hill out of town, look for an Adopt-A-Highway sign just before the State Boat Launch. The driveway is immediately to the left after that sign. The Highland Lodge is the third and last one on that driveway.
